6	Boils	9:8-12	All the Egyptians	--	--	--
7	Fiery hail & thunder	9:13-35	None in Goshen	--	“I have sinned this time: the LORD is righteous, ... I will let you go ... (vv. 27-28)	--
8	Locusts	10:1-20	Though not stated, Goshen is still severed	--	“Go, serve the LORD your God: but who are they that shall go?” (v. 8)	“go now ye that are men ...” (v. 11; see also vv. 9-10)
9	Thick darkness	10:21-29	All the children of Israel had light	--	“Go ye, serve the LORD; ... let your little ones also go with you.” (v. 24)	“only let your flocks and your herds be stayed: ...” (v. 24)
10	Death of firstborn	11:1-10 & 12:29-32	Israel, both man and beast, passed over	--	“Rise up, ... and go, serve the LORD ... take your flocks and your herds” (vv. 31-32)	“and [Pharaoh, king of Egypt] ... pursued after the children of Israel: ...” (14:8)
