- D. Spiritual growth is much more than Bible knowledge.
- E. Spiritual growth is not measured by religious activity.
- F. Spiritual growth is not marked by material prosperity.

- In order to grow spiritually, you must ...
- 1. Purposefully remove hindrances to growth.
- 2. Actively foster conditions that lead to growth.
- 3. Keep your focus on Jesus—our Savior and Lord.
- 4. Recognize how desperately you need God's grace to grow.
