



Christmas According to Jesus

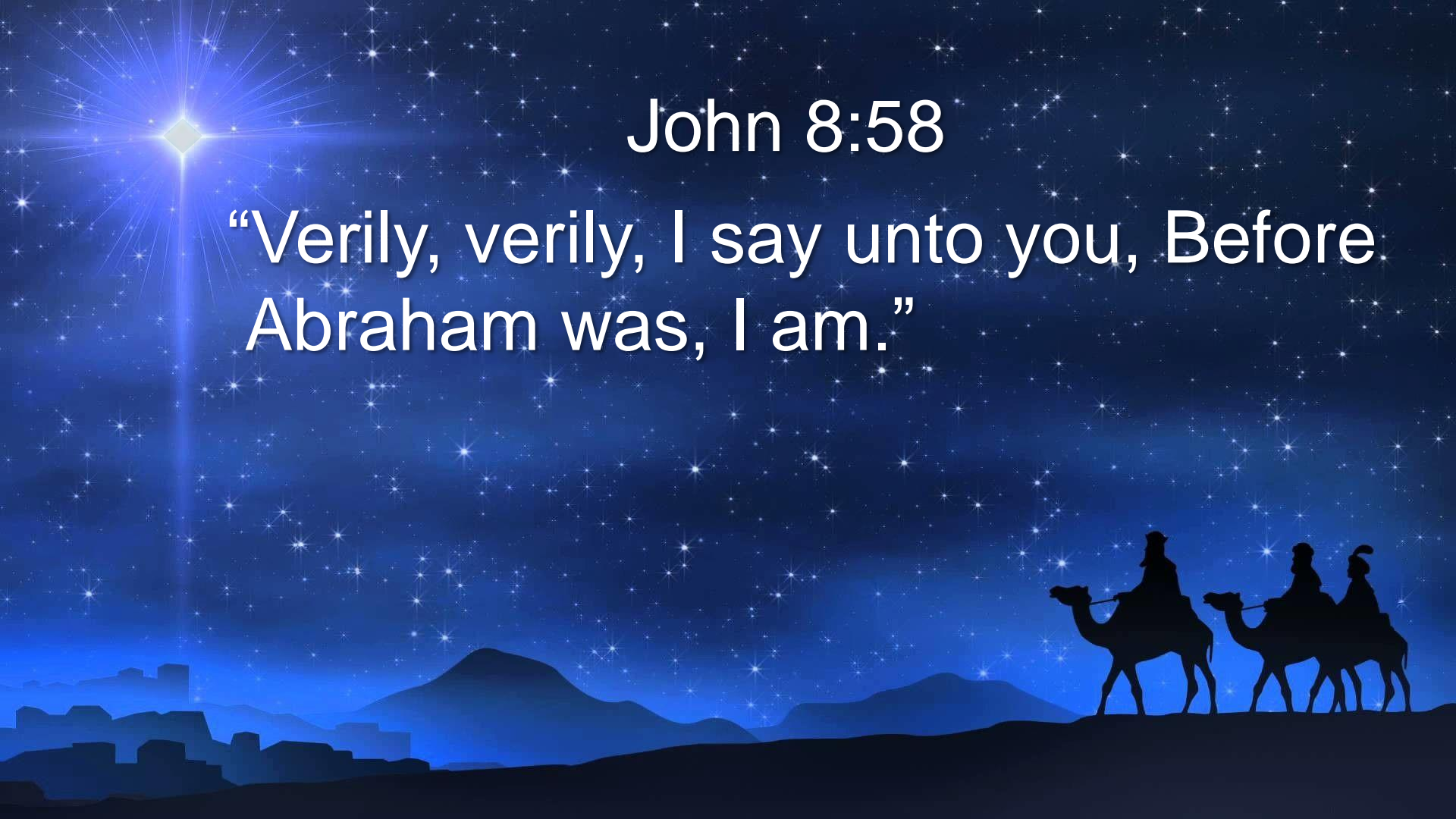
Hebrews 10:5-7






