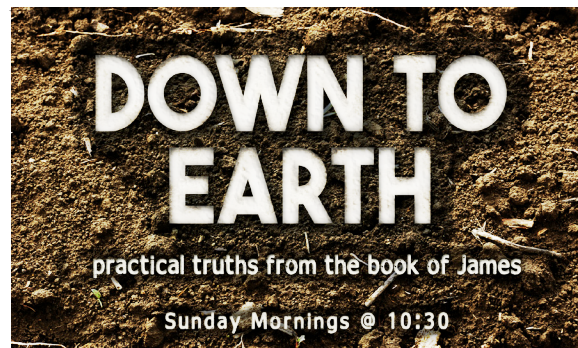

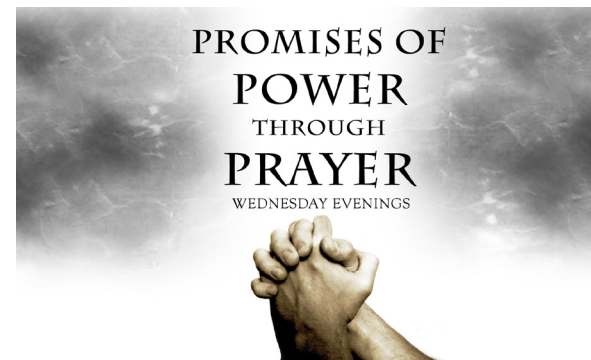

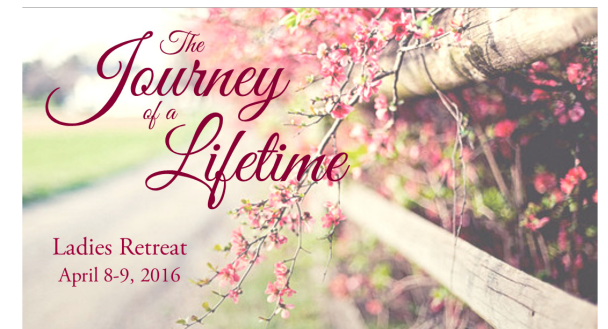


Ladies' Fellowship
