Missions Team Report

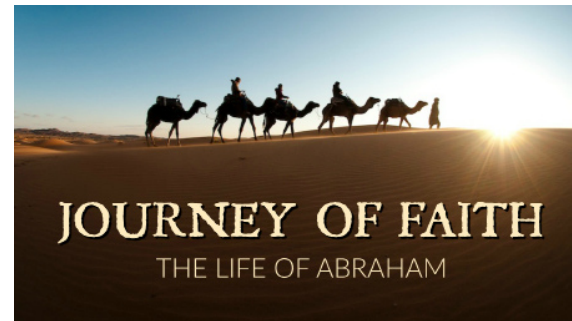
The missions team will be reporting about their trip next Sunday evening. Please join us in hearing about their time spent in Hungary.
