A Lesson for us from Israel's history ...

vv. 1-4 “all” (x5) experienced God's blessing

vv. 5-6 “many” (“most”) displeased God

vv. 7-11 particular ways “some of them” (x4) displeased God

Conclusion / Application (“Wherefore ...”)

vv. 12-13 Recognize the danger of temptation—don’t be prideful or careless.

v. 14 “Flee from idolatry!” (which begins the next section)
