- 2. Wearing their hair short vs. long**
- 3. Wearing “loosed hair”**









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**What is Paul saying we should do in our culture, in our church, in our day?**

- 1. Women should wear some sort of physical head covering.**
- 2. Women should wear their hair in a long or decidedly feminine style.**
- 3. Women should wear their hair “up.”**
