#### Doing more harm than good ...

1. Their fellowship gatherings were dividing God's people, rather than uniting them.

#### **Acts 20:7**

"And upon the first day of the week, when the disciples came together to break bread, Paul preached unto them, ready to depart on the morrow; and continued his speech until midnight."

#### **Jude 12**

"These are spots in your <u>feasts of</u> <u>charity</u>, when they feast with you, feeding themselves without fear: ..."
