Speaking of Tongues 1 Corinthians 14:13-25

1. Spiritual gifts, rightly used, edify others.

A. Prophecy speaks to men; tongues speak to God.

B. Prophecy edifies the church; tongues edify only the speaker.

2. In order for the spoken word to edify, it must be understood.
