Concluding message in the series “Trusting God by Name”

Jesus is our Savior. **He is Emmanuel, God with us.** That means ...

1. He is ***Jehovah***, the great I AM, who enters into a loving relationship with His people.  
John 17:23 “I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.”
2. He is ***Elohim***, the Sovereign Creator God of everything that is.  
Col. 1:16-17 “For by him [Jesus] were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him: 17 And he is before all things, and by him all things consist.”
3. He is ***Adonai***, the Owner, Master, Ruler, and Lord of all.  
Luke 6:46 “And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?”
4. He is ***El Shaddai***, the All-Powerful and All-Sufficient One.  
Rev. 1:8 “I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.”
5. He is ***El Olam***, the Eternal, Everlasting God.  
Heb. 1:8-12 “But unto the Son he [the Father] saith, Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: ... And, Thou, Lord, in the beginning hast laid the foundation of the earth; and the heavens are the works of thine hands: They shall perish; but thou remainest; ... and they shall be changed: but thou art the same, and thy years shall not fail.”
6. He is ***El Elyon***, the exalted Most High God, who is worthy of all the honor and praise we can give.  
Rev. 5:13 “And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, be unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.”
7. He is ***Jehovah Tsidkenu***, the LORD our Righteousness  
2 Cor. 5:21 “For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.”
8. He is ***Jehovah Nissi***, the LORD my Banner, to whom I can look for victory.  
John 16:33 “These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.”

9. He is ***Jehovah Ra'ah***, the LORD my Shepherd who lovingly leads and guides me; comforts, protects, and provides for me.

John 10:27 “My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:”

10. He is ***Jehovah Sabaoth***, the LORD of Hosts, who protects and fights for His people.

Rev. 19:11 “And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.”

11. He is ***Jehovah Jireh***, the LORD our Provider, who knows and ministers to our every need.

John 6:35 “And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.”

12. He is ***Jehovah Mekaddeshkem***, the LORD who Sanctifies, who has set us apart to Himself as His precious people.

1 Cor. 1:30 “But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:”

13. He is ***Jehovah Rapha***, the LORD who Heals you—whether your hurt is a physical, emotional or spiritual infirmity, He is the Great Physician.

Matt. 4:23 “And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people.”

14. He is ***El Roi***, the God who Sees, hears, knows, and cares.

Mark 6:34 “And Jesus, when he came out, saw much people, and was moved with compassion toward them, because they were as sheep not having a shepherd: ...”

15. Jesus is ***Emmanuel***, God with us. He is the magnificent God described in all these names.

Matt. 1:23 “Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.
