What is Exodus about?

- ◆ Written by Moses
- ◆ Exodus continues the story of God's people from Genesis.
- ◆ Israel was in bondage in Egypt.
- ◆ God is calling his people to leave the oppression of Egypt and come and serve Him.

1. We must live by faith, not by fear.

vv. 1-5

- ◇ By faith Moses, when he was born, was hid three months of his parents, because they saw he was a proper child; and they were not afraid of the king's commandment. Heb. 11:23
- ◇ And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth. Gen. 1:28
