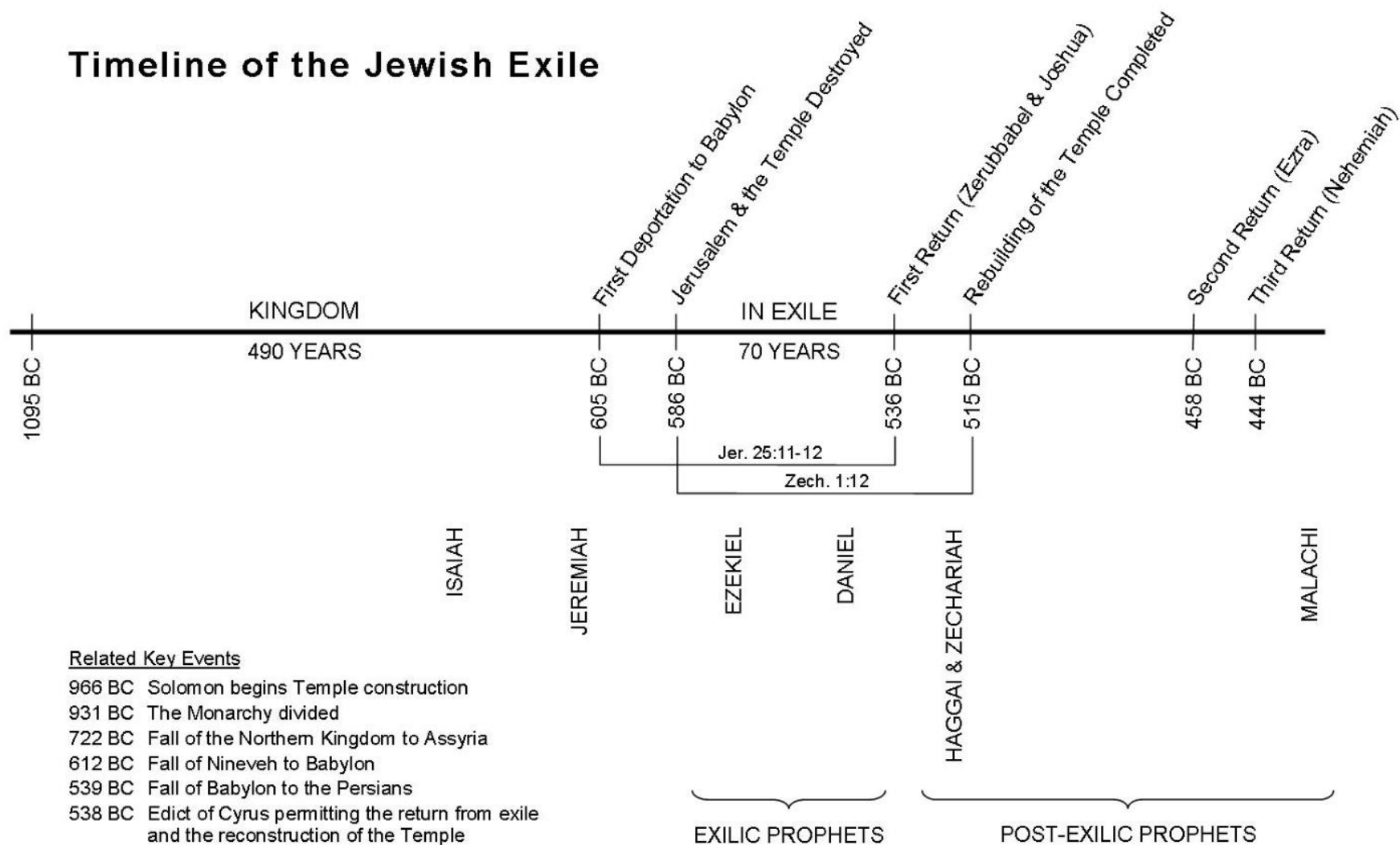




Timeline of the Jewish Exile



Related Key Events

- 966 BC Solomon begins Temple construction
- 931 BC The Monarchy divided
- 722 BC Fall of the Northern Kingdom to Assyria
- 612 BC Fall of Nineveh to Babylon
- 539 BC Fall of Babylon to the Persians
- 538 BC Edict of Cyrus permitting the return from exile and the reconstruction of the Temple
