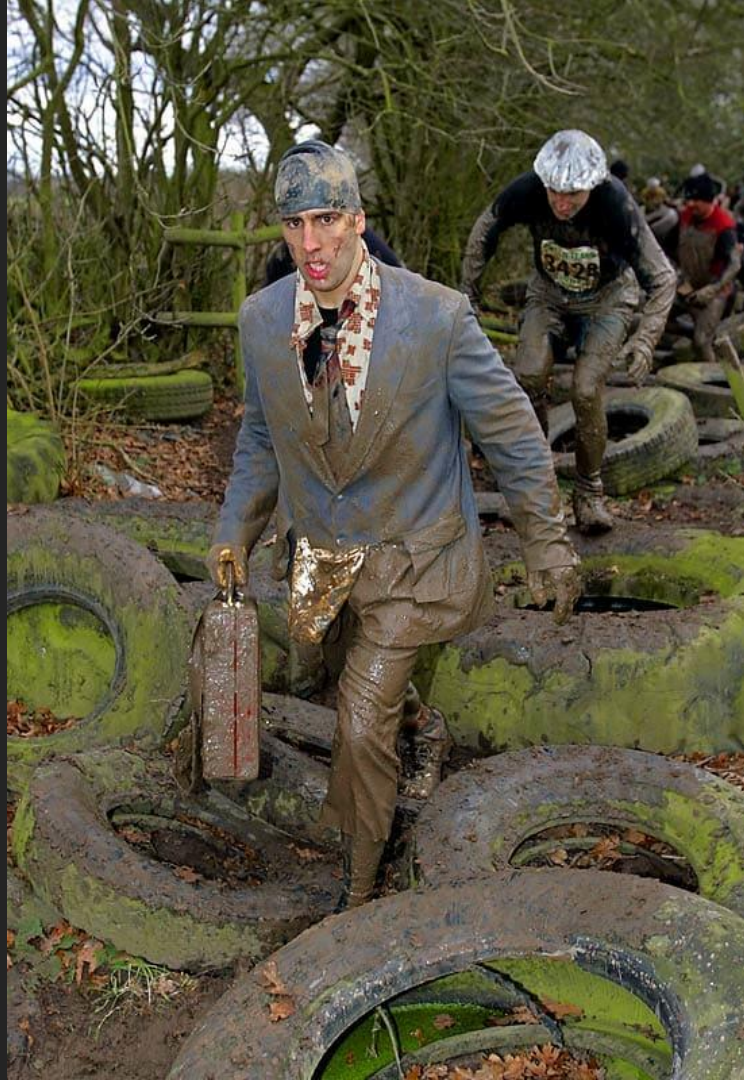

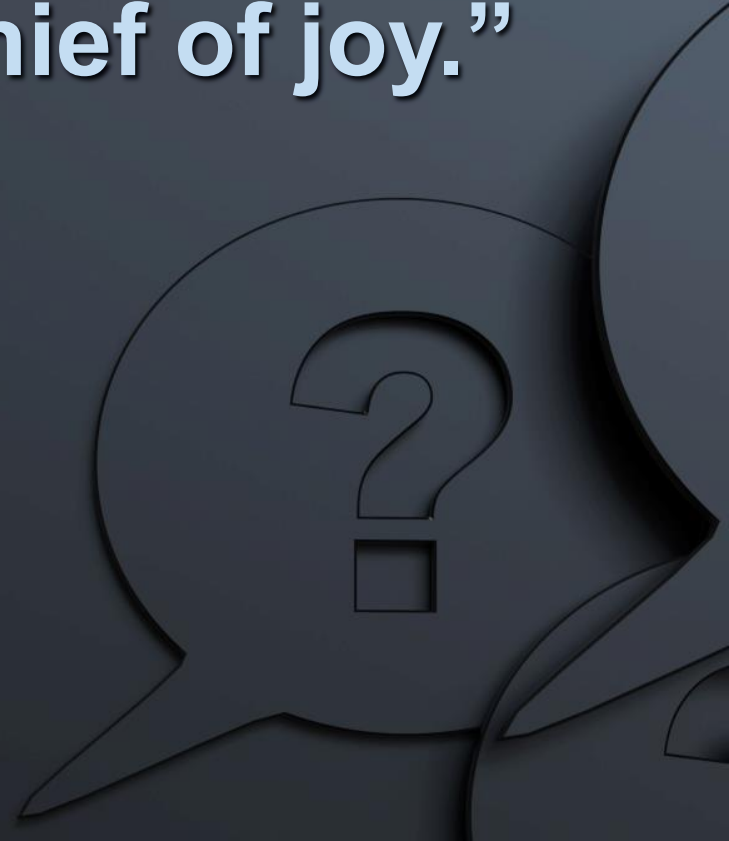

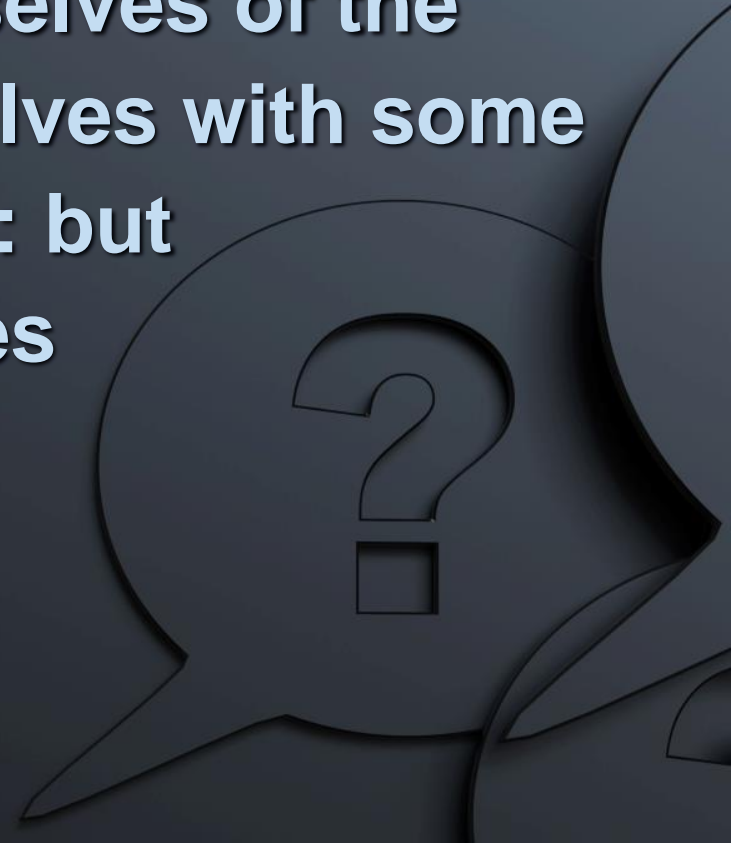


1. Comparing ourselves with others leads to pride, jealousy, resentment, and insecurity.

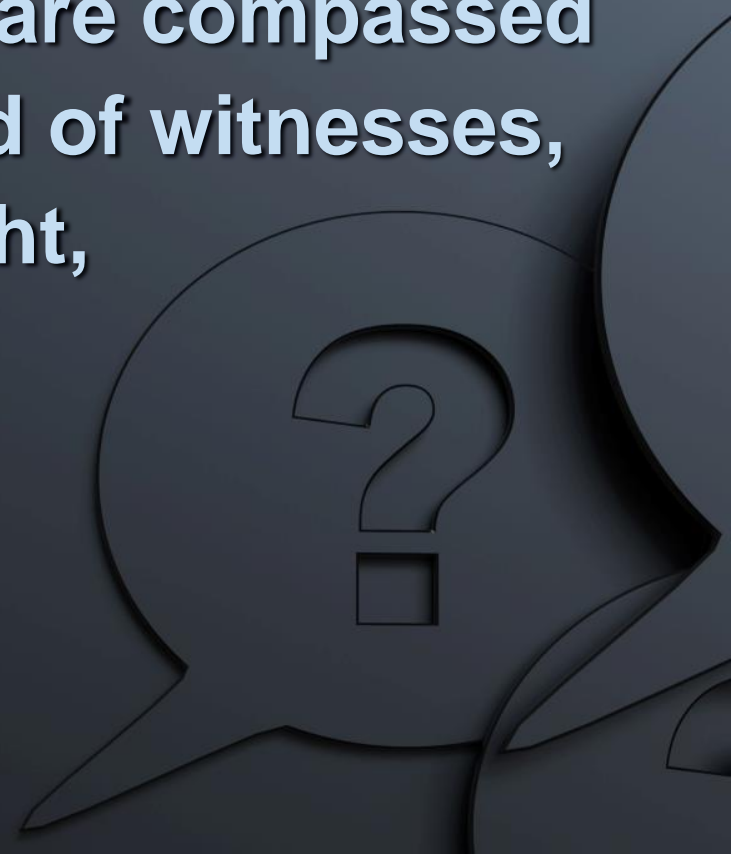

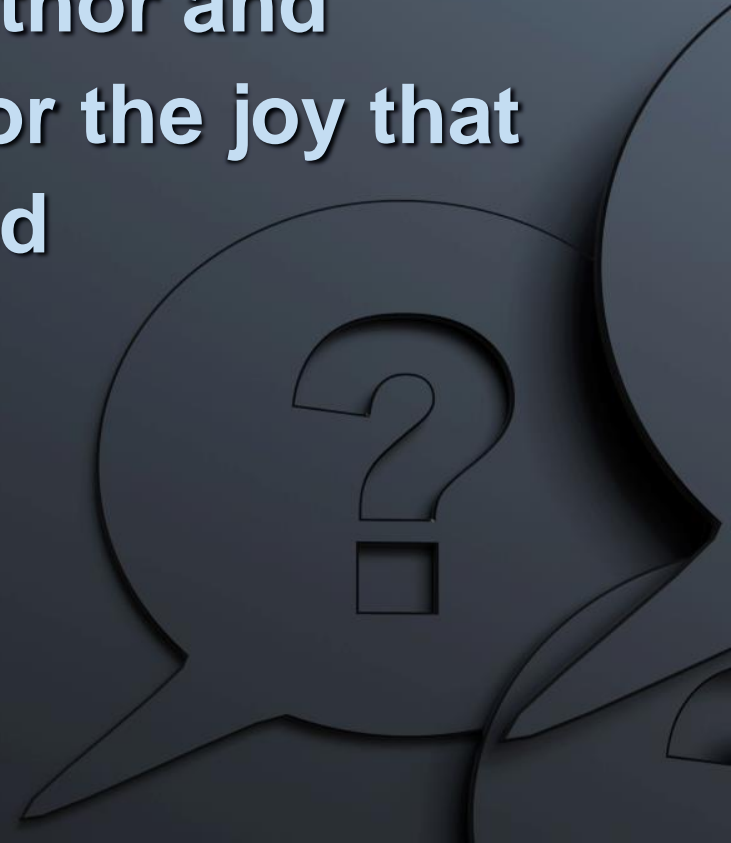
Hebrews 12:1
