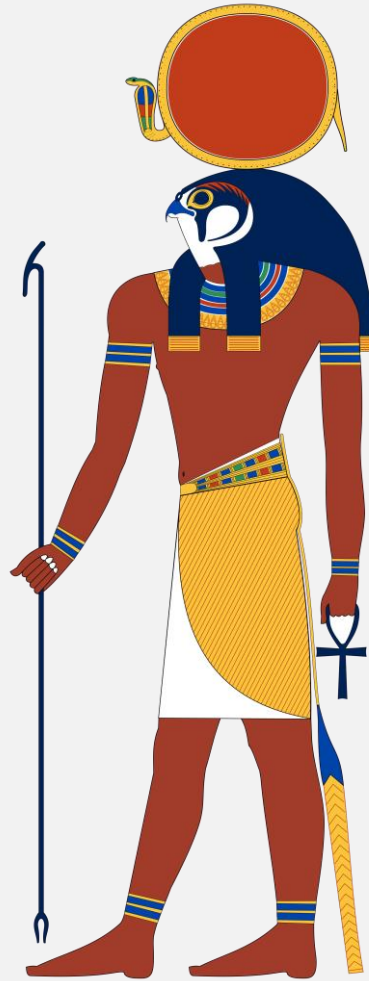

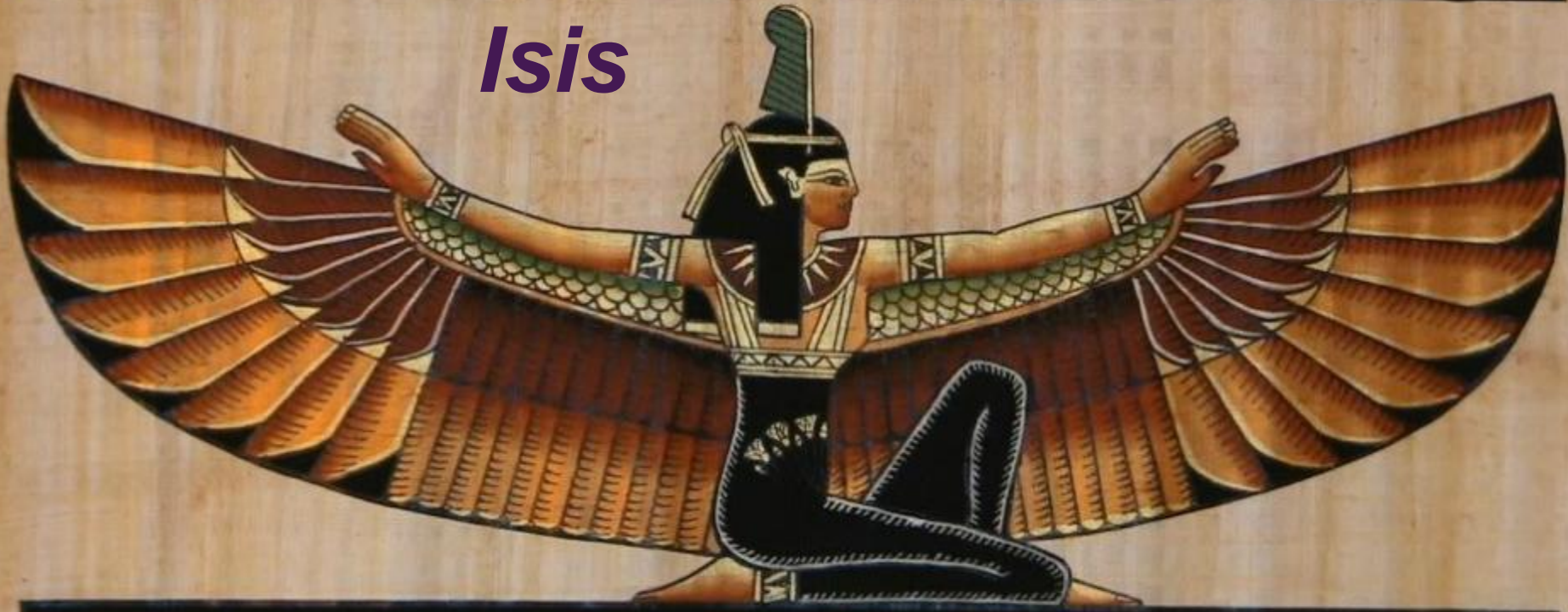

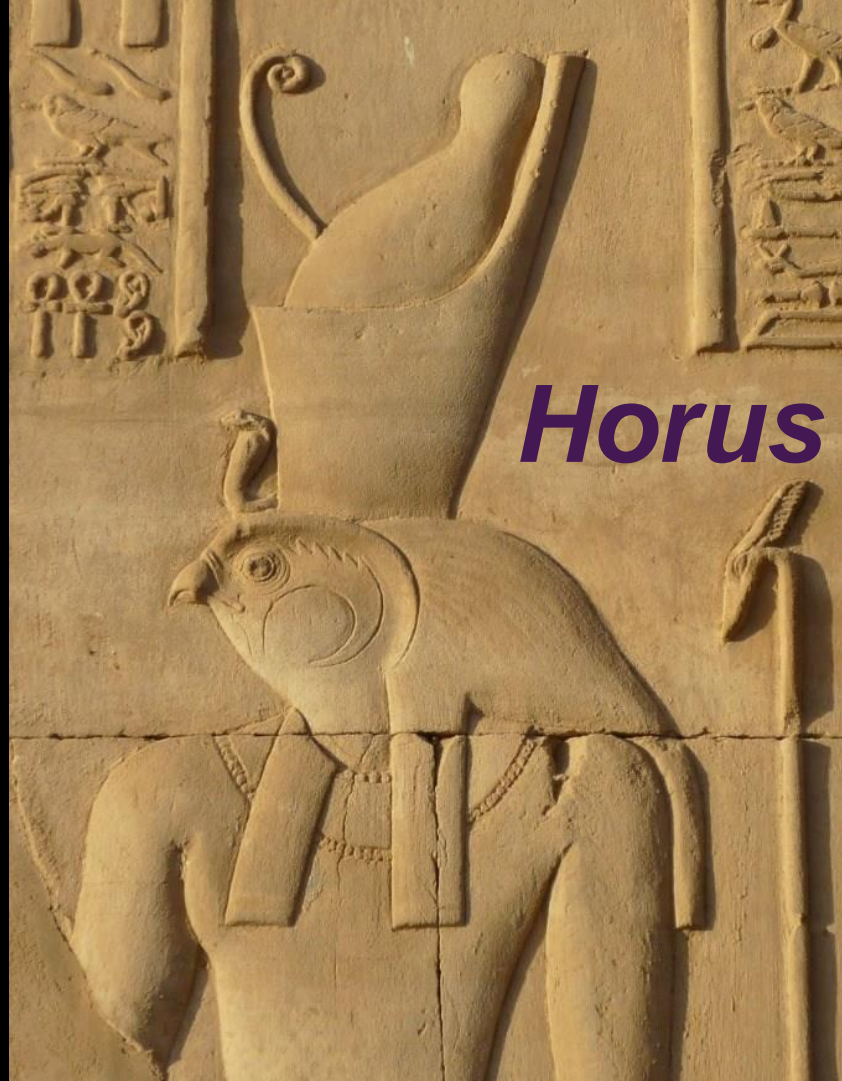

YHWH


YeHoWaH → Jehovah

memorial unto all generations.”**






3. God demands our total devotion.
