***Jeremiah's Prayer
for Deliverance from
the Power of Sin***

Jeremiah 17:14



- 1. It's easy for believers to drift into a sterile, self-affirming form of Christianity.**
- 2. It's easy to take umbrage over the sin we see in the world around us, and yet be complacent about our own sin.**
- 3. It's easy to lose sight of how offensive our sin is to our holy God.**

- 4. It's easy to become oblivious to the effect our sin has on those around us.**
- 5. It's easy to think of our salvation only as an event settled in the past and lose sight of how desperately we need God's continued hand of healing and salvation.**

- D. Keep your focus on the one true object and source of praise.**

E. Never lose sight of how desperately you need God's healing and salvation in the face of your own sinful heart.
