- **God led them into the Land (43-45a)**

v. 45b A renewed call for praise

covenant = *berith*

1 Peter 2:9

“But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light.”

- (1) God's covenant people belong to Him because He chose them—not because they deserve it.**
- (2) Nothing can stop God's purposes for His people.**
- (3) God does His work in our lives according to His timetable and His plans.**
- (4) God brings trials into our lives so we'll remember how much we need Him.**
- (5) God will accomplish His sovereign purpose for us and bring us safely to glory.**
