Luke 12:8-12

1. vv. 8-9: Publicly confess Christ (speak about Christ), not deny Christ.
2. v. 10: Speaking against Christ can be forgiven but not blaspheming the Spirit.
3. vv. 11-12: If you speak to hostile authorities, God will give you what to say.

Main Truth #1

**Whoever declares Christ publicly is saved,
but whoever denies Christ is not.**

Main Truth #2

**Whoever rejects the Spirit's testimony
about Christ will not be forgiven.**

**But whoever speaks a word against Christ
can be forgiven if he repents.**

Luke 12:8-12

1. God will be gracious to those whose life declares their faith in Christ.
2. God will be gracious to forgive momentary failures if we repent.
3. God will be gracious to show you what you ought to say.

Main Truth #3

When you speak for Jesus, the Holy Spirit will teach you.

3. If you speak to hostile authorities, God will graciously give you what to say.
