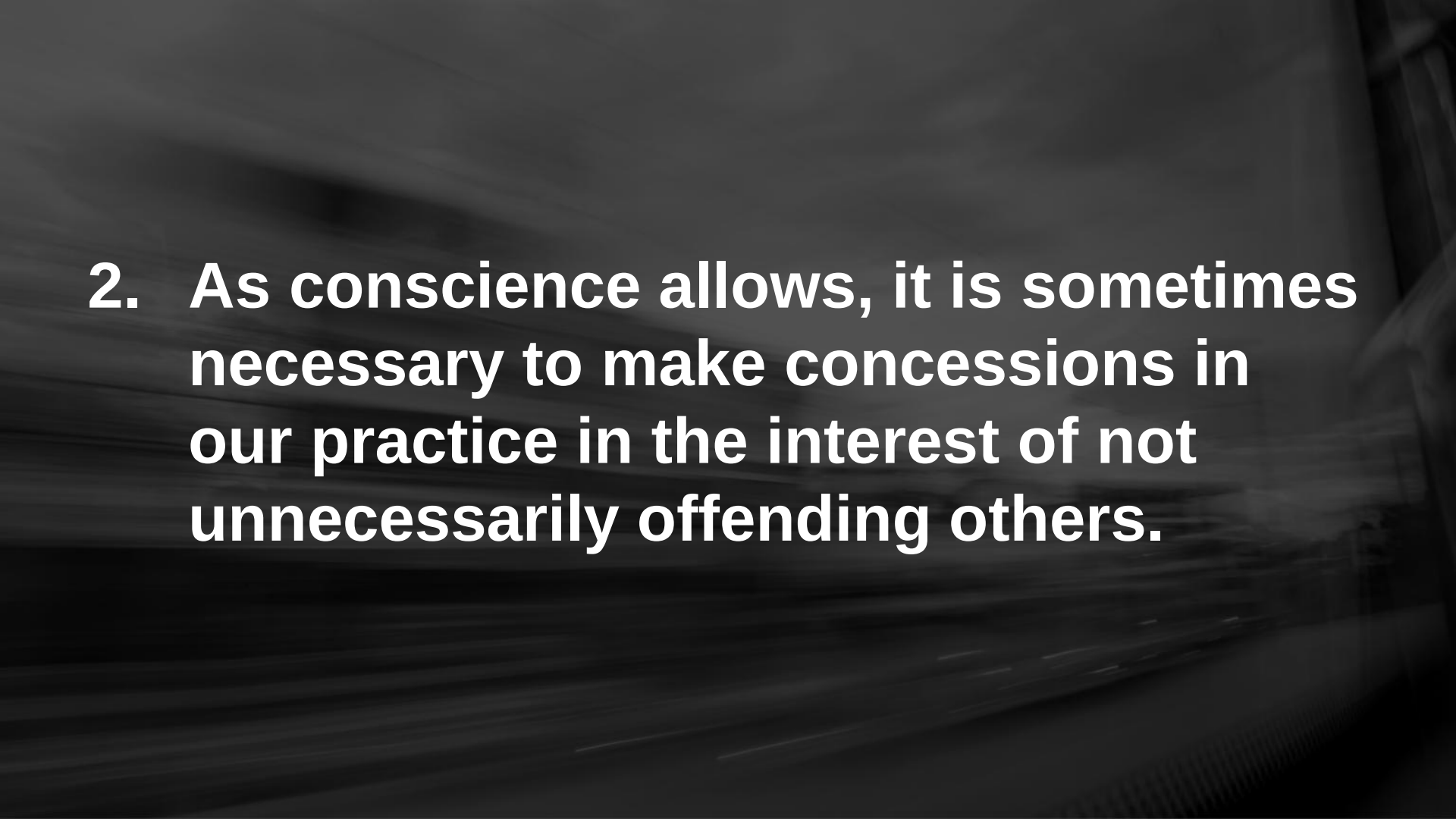

Concession Without Compromise

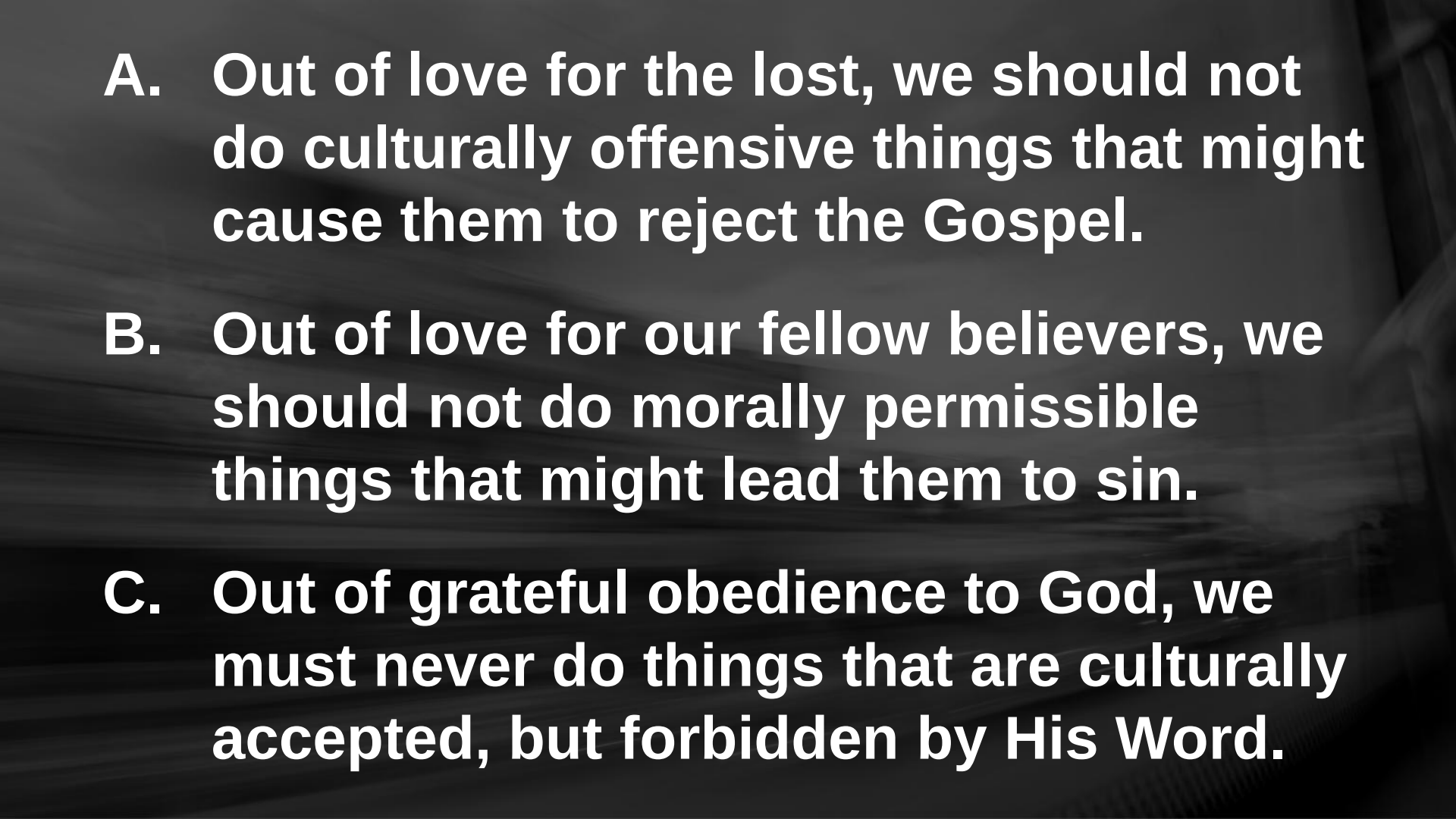
Acts 15:13-35

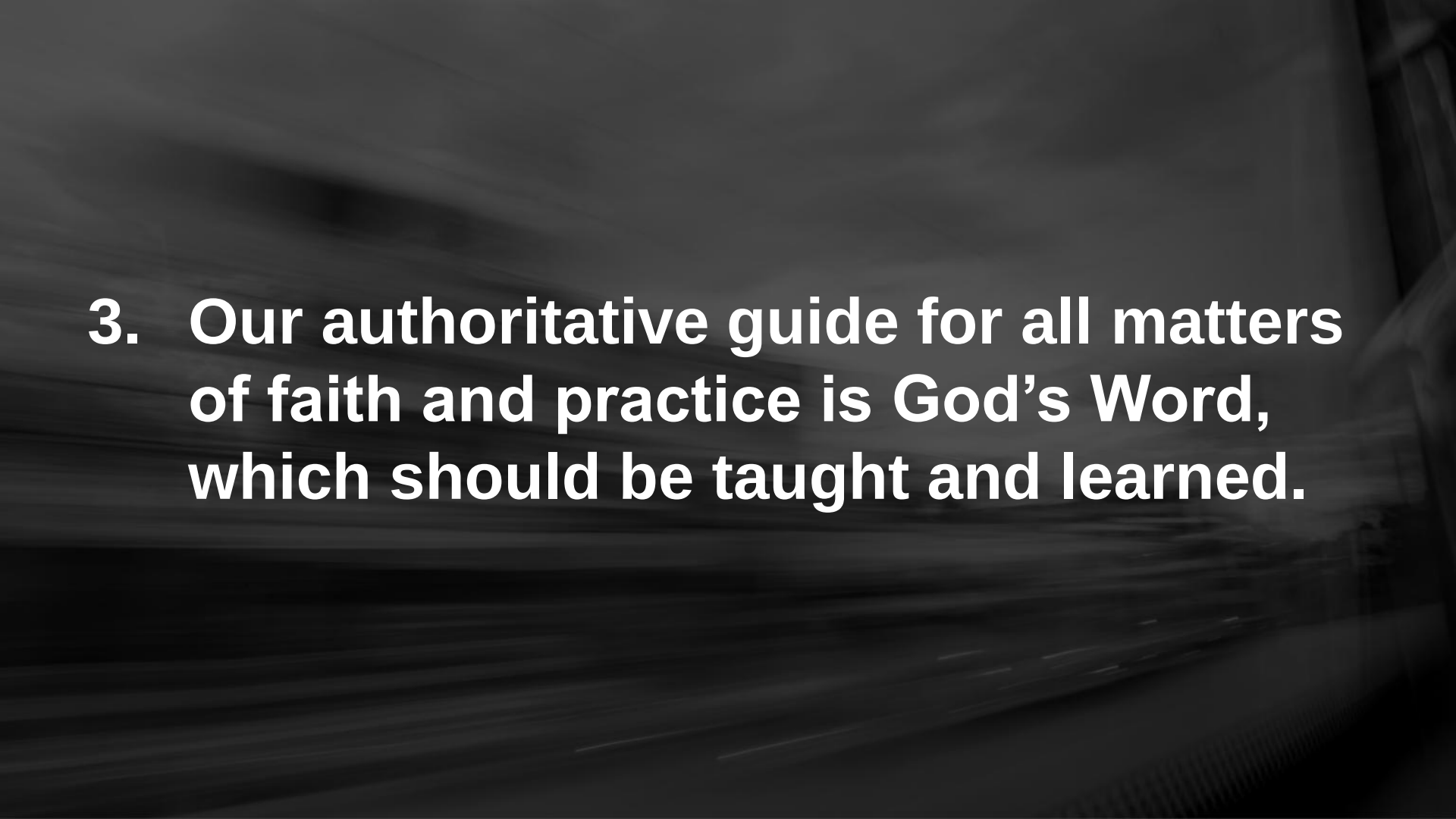
1. We must be uncompromising when it comes to the gospel:

Salvation is by God's grace alone through faith alone in Christ alone.



2. As conscience allows, it is sometimes necessary to make concessions in our practice in the interest of not unnecessarily offending others.

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- A. Out of love for the lost, we should not do culturally offensive things that might cause them to reject the Gospel.**
 - B. Out of love for our fellow believers, we should not do morally permissible things that might lead them to sin.**
 - C. Out of grateful obedience to God, we must never do things that are culturally accepted, but forbidden by His Word.**
